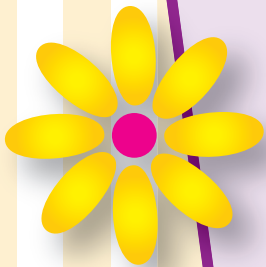
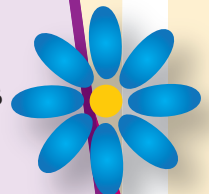
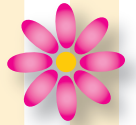




Read and discuss the following helpful safety tips.

STEPS FOR STAYING SAFE

- Return a signed parent/guardian permission slip and your current year registration to your Girl Scout adults.
- Observe and follow all Girl Scout Safety-Wise and council guidelines.
- Use the buddy system at all times.
- Girl Scout Daisies, Brownies and Juniors must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Girl Scout Cadettes, Seniors and Ambassadors must be supervised by an adult when selling door-to-door and must never sell alone. Adults should be present at a booth in public places at all times.
- Be familiar with the areas and neighborhoods in which you sell. Use safe pedestrian practices at all times.
- Always have a plan for safeguarding money – avoid walking around with large amounts of cash. Turn over money to supervising adults to deposit as directed by your council.
- Never enter the home of a stranger or sell to persons in vehicles.
- Dress appropriately for weather conditions.
